

CHAPTER 2.03
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
**POLICE DEPARTMENT/
STREET DEPARTMENT,**
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
GOVERNING OF SAME

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in the City of Rothsay, a police department/street department consisting of a Chief of Police and such other officers as may be deemed necessary by the City Council from time to time.

SECTION 2. The Chief of Police and such other officers shall be appointed by the City Council. The Chief of Police or any officer may be removed by the Council at any time at the Council's discretion.

SECTION 3. The Chief of Police shall have control over the department. He/she shall report to the Council, at its regular meetings, as to the needs of the department and work performed by the members of the department. He/she shall be responsible for the proper training and discipline of the members of the police department/street department and may suspend any members for refusal or neglect to obey orders pending final action by the Council on his/her discharge or retention.

SECTION 4. The members of the police department/street department shall enforce the ordinances and statutes applicable to the City, bring violators before the proper court and make complaints against such person or persons for offenses committed coming to his/her knowledge. The members of the police department/street department shall serve processes on behalf of Rothsay and shall serve such notices as may, from time to time, be required by the Council. Said officers shall be entitled to the same fees as provided by the general statutes for constables for Rothsay and all such fees shall be paid to the City Clerk/Treasurer of Rothsay.

SECTION 5. The police department/street department shall keep a record, and all persons arrested for violation of the ordinances of Rothsay shall be recorded there, with names, places of resistance, time when arrested, nature of the offense with which they are charged, whether or not committed to jail, when and where examined, whether acquitted or convicted, the amount of the fine and costs separately, the length of the imprisonment, whether said fine and costs were paid and to whom, and the department shall produce and exhibit said books, records and entries to the Council of Rothsay or to any committee thereof on order of the Council.

SECTION 6. The police department/street department shall perform such duties as are necessary to maintain in good repair the streets, sidewalks, water system and sewer system. Records of such activity shall be maintained as directed by the City Council.
